13	Any person who knowingly uses or attempts to use an unmanned aircraft system as defined in
14	§ 19.2-60.1 while (i) committing or attempting to commit a crime, (ii) obstructing or attempting to
15	obstruct the delivery of emergency medical services by emergency medical services agency personnel, or
16	(iii) obstructing or attempting to obstruct any law-enforcement officer or animal control officer in the
17	performance of his duties is guilty of a Class 1 misdemeanor. A violation of this section is a separate
