SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 100

Celebrating the life of Kathleen Flanagan McManus.

WHEREAS, as the loving matriarch of a large family, Kate McManus' proudest vocation was her role as a mother, grandmother, and great-grandmother; and

WHEREAS, Kate McManus will be fondly remembered and greatly missed by her husband of 60 years, Reginald; children, Christopher, Kathy, Patrick, Anna, John, and their families; and numerous other family members and friends; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED by the Senate, the House of Delegates concurring, That the General Assembly hereby note with great sadness the loss of Kathleen Flanagan McManus, an admired caregiver, and a beloved wife and mother in the Springfield community; and, be it
