5.	<b>Summary:</b> Adds certain chemical substances to Schedule I of the Drug Control Act. The Board of Pharmacy has added these substances to Schedule I in an expedited regulatory process. A substance added via this process is removed from the schedule after 18 months unless a general law is enacted adding the substance to the schedule.

8.	<b>Fiscal Implications:</b> This bill would not have a fiscal impact on the Commonwealth. This bill adds certain chemicals to the Schedule I of the Drug Control Act. Because the Board of Pharmacy has already added the 12 compounds specified in the proposal to Schedule I of the Drug Control Act, the proposed legislation is not expected to have any additional impact on the state-responsible (prison) bed space needs of the Commonwealth.
