5.	<b>Summary:</b> This bill allows the Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV) to issue a driving privilege card to those granted a period of stay authorized by the Attorney General of the United States who are not otherwise eligible for a temporary driver's license. The bill provides that such driving privilege card is subject to the same requirements and conditions as a temporary driver's license.

8.	<b>Fiscal Implications:</b> The systems changes required to implement this legislation are estimated to cost \$278,500. While there would be an expenditure impact associated with the issuance of driving privilege cards (including production costs for the credentials and an increase in the number of transactions in DMV Customer Service Centers), the magnitude of that impact cannot be estimated. In any event, it is believed that the expenditure impact would likely be offset by the revenue impact of the additional fees collected from issuance of driving privilege cards.
