3. Committee: Privileges and Elections

4. Title: Senate districts; adjustment.

5. Summary: Changes district assignments of two census precincts (VTDs) in Louisa County. The bill moves Fredericks Hall Precinct from District 17 to District 22 and South Anna Precinct from District 22 to District 17. The population deviation for both districts remains under two percent.

6. Budget Amendment Necessary: No.

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Preliminary – see Item 8.

8. Fiscal Implications: Section 24.2-404, Code of Virginia, requires the Department of Elections to provide general registrars voter confirmation documents for newly registered voters and notice to registered voters on the system changes and corrections in their registration records and polling places. The Department of Elections cannot estimate the number of voters affected by this bill at this time because it does not maintain data that ties precinct boundaries to census precincts, which are the basis of redistricting adjustments in this bill; therefore, the fiscal impact for the Department of Elections cannot be determined at this time.

The proposed legislation is expected to have a local fiscal impact because localities are responsible for mailing voter information letters, for which mailing costs are estimated to be \$0.49 per voter.
