4. Title: Local law enforcement and State Police; enforcement of executive actions or orders.

5. Summary: The proposal prohibits local law enforcement or the Department of State Police from cooperating with a federal agency through the furnishing of police services for the purpose of enforcing an executive action or order related to firearms, ammunition, or components or combination thereof that has not been made law by an act of Congress.

8. Fiscal Implications: The Department of State Police (Department) believes that there could be a potential reduction or possible elimination of federal grants it receives to support various public safety initiatives as a result of the proposed bill.

Such grants include funding the Department receives to support initiatives for improved record reporting to the National Instant Criminal Background Check System (NICS) supported by the Office of Justice Program under the U.S. Department of Justice.

The proposal may also potentially impact law enforcement agencies. However, the impact on localities is indeterminate.
