**4. Title:** Virginia Small Business Financing Authority; Small, Women-owned, and Minority-owned Business.

**5. Summary:** This bill clarifies that the Small, Women-owned, and Minority-owned Business Loan Fund is a permanent revolving loan fund, and that moneys collected as a result of loan repayments to the Fund are to be paid directly to the Virginia Small Business Financing Authority for purposes of reimbursing the Fund and extending new direct loans to eligible small, women-owned, and minority-owned businesses.

Fiscal Implications:** It is anticipated that this bill will not result in a fiscal impact to the Department of Small Business and Supplier Diversity or the Virginia Small Business Financing Authority.
