**2. Patron:** Yost

**3. Committee:** Transportation

**4. Title:** Bicycle helmets required to be worn by riders.

**5. Summary:** Requires every rider of a bicycle or electric power-assisted bicycle less than 18 years of age to wear a helmet. Currently, localities may by ordinance require riders of bicycles, electric power-assisted bicycles, electric personal assistive mobility devices, or toy vehicles who are 14 years of age or younger to wear helmets.

**6. Budget Amendment Necessary:** No.

**7. Fiscal Impact Estimates:** Indeterminate. See Item 8.

**8. Fiscal Implications:** This legislation could result in additional revenues from the fine applied to this new offense. It is impossible to determine the magnitude of the potential impact because there is no way to project the amount of violations of this provision that will occur. Any revenue collected would be deposited in the Literary Fund.

Localities are currently permitted to enact similar ordinances to require riders of bicycles, electric power-assisted bicycles, electric personal assistive mobility devices, or toy vehicles who are 14 years of age or younger, to wear helmets. This legislation does not affect local ordinances or revenues; any revenue collected by a locality would belong to that locality.

**9. Specific Agency or Political Subdivisions Affected:** Law enforcement agencies.

**10. Technical Amendment Necessary:** Yes; Line 17, space needed between “bicycle” and “on.” Line 19, space needed between “helmet” and “that.”
