4. Title: Weight limits; increases maximum gross weight of a motor vehicle eligible for an overload permit

5. Summary: This bill increases the maximum gross weight of a motor vehicle eligible for an overload permit, based on axle spacing and number of axles on such vehicle, from 84,000 pounds to 90,000 pounds.

6. Budget Amendment Necessary: No.

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Indeterminate. See Item #8.

8. Fiscal Implications: The Virginia Department of Transportation has expressed concern that, with a higher weight limit, the needed maintenance on the Commonwealth's roads and bridges will be accelerated, increasing the costs of the department. The amount of increased costs is indeterminate at this time.
