4. Title: License plates, special; issuance for supporters of Family and Children's Trust Fund

5. Summary: This bill prohibits the Department of Motor Vehicles from issuing to registered sex offenders special license plates for supporters of the Family and Children's Trust Fund of Virginia bearing the legend KIDS FIRST or renewing the registration for a vehicle that has been issued such license plates.

6. Budget Amendment Necessary: No.

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Preliminary. See Item #8.

8. Fiscal Implications: This legislation would require an estimated \$38,493 in information technology development costs, which can be absorbed within existing resources. In addition, records show that there are currently five individuals in the Sex Offender and Crimes Against Minors registry that have the KIDS FIRST special plate. The agency would be required to decline to reissue this special plate to these individuals, resulting in \$125 in decreased revenue for the Family and Children's Trust Fund each year.
