4. Title: Private animal shelter; a facility operates for purpose of finding permanent homes for animals.

5. Summary: This substitute bill requires the Board of Agriculture and Consumer Services to adopt regulations that establish the purposes of private animal shelters. The regulations adopted by the Board shall ensure that no private animal shelter shall be prohibited from operating a private animal shelter solely on the basis of disposition outcomes in Section 3.2-6548, Code of Virginia.
