4. Title: Uninsured motor vehicle fee payment plan

5. Summary: This bill allows the Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV) to establish an uninsured motor vehicle fee payment plan to allow individuals to pay the \$500 uninsured motor vehicle statutory fee through an installment plan with the Department, when their driver's license and vehicle registration have been suspended as a result of failure to pay the uninsured motor vehicle fee. The bill has a delayed effective date of January 1, 2017.

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Preliminary. See Item #8.

8. Fiscal Implications: A one-time cost of \$160,965 is anticipated to develop an installment payment process and to change DMVNow processes to allow for installment payments. The staff hours required to implement this can be accomplished during normal work schedules; therefore the agency expects to absorb this cost. In addition, the \$25 service fee paid by enrollees is expected to offset both initial implementation costs and subsequent ongoing administrative costs.
