3. Committee: Senate Transportation

4. Title: Thomas Jefferson Scenic Byway Loop; Virginia byway designation.

5. Summary: Designates portions of Virginia Route 72, Virginia Route 619, and U.S. Route 58 Alternate in the Counties of Scott and Wise and the City of Norton the "Thomas Jefferson Scenic Byway Loop." Such designations are typically authorized by the Commonwealth Transportation Board.

8. Fiscal Implications: According to the Department of Transportation (VDOT), this designation will require the addition of six signs. The cost per sign is approximately \$850. This legislation also requires VDOT to provide ongoing maintenance of the signage. The cost for maintenance is unknown. However VDOT maintains that this can be absorbed within their current budget.
