**4. Title:** Adult day care centers; exempt from licensure, Program for All-Inclusive Care for the Elderly.

**5. Summary:** Licensure of adult day care centers; Program for All-Inclusive Care for the Elderly programs exempt. Exempts adult day care centers that provide services only to individuals enrolled in a Program of All-Inclusive Care for the Elderly (PACE) program from the requirement of a license issued by the Department of Social Services.

**8. Fiscal Implications:** This bill has a negligible fiscal impact. There will be a minimal reduction in revenue based on a decline of application fees and civil penalties. Total loss in revenue for application fees under this bill is estimated to be less than \$2,000 a year based on the current number of PACE program facilities.
