**4. Title:** Request for Proposal of design-build projects.

**5. Summary:** Allows for the submission and consideration of alternative technical concepts, defined in the bill, during the Request for Proposal process of a design-build transportation project.

**6. Budget Amendment Necessary:** No.

**7. Fiscal Impact Estimates:** Preliminary. See Item 8

**8. Fiscal Implications:** According to the Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT), a revision has been made by the Federal Highway Administration which eliminated the requirement to submit a base proposal when a contracting agency allows design-build proposers to submit alternative technical concepts (ATC) in the technical and price proposals. This simplifies the requirements involved regarding ATCs

According to VDOT, there could be some savings associated with this legislation. It is impossible to determine the extent of the savings at this time.
