4. Title: Certification of online driver education courses

5. Summary: This bill provides that, upon application of a driver training school licensed in accordance with Chapter 17 of Title 46.2, the Commissioner may license such driver training school using criteria established by the Commissioner pursuant to § 46.2-1702 to provide computer-based driver education courses using curricula approved by the Commissioner. The content and quality of such online courses shall be comparable to that of courses offered in the Commonwealth's public schools.
