5.	<b>Summary:</b> Updates the description of the offshore waters over which the Commonwealth has jurisdiction. In place of a reference to certain seas claimed in the Virginia Constitution of 1776, the bill provides for jurisdiction over offshore waters for a distance of three geographical miles as determined by metes and bounds surveys approved by the Virginia Institute of Marine Science and the Marine Resources Commission. This bill also directs the Secretary of Natural Resources to execute the metes and bounds surveys and to request that the Attorney General file the surveys in the United States Supreme Court to fix the three-mile boundary.
