**4. Title:** Insurance notices; electronic delivery.

**5. Summary:** Insurance notices; electronic delivery. Authorizes any health insurer offering health insurance coverage to provide an electronic evidence of coverage to the policyholder, unless the policyholder requests a written copy, which shall be provided at no charge. The measure also provides that provisions authorizing electronic delivery of insurance notifications shall apply only to the group policyholder for any health insurance contract and shall not apply to individual health insurance policies.
