4. Title: Virginia National Guard; possession of handguns by members at certain facilities.

5. Summary: The bill will allow members of the Virginia National Guard who hold a concealed handgun permit to carry a concealed weapon while at National Guard facilities and facilities under contract with the National Guard. The bill also provides that the member's commanding officer may prohibit the member from possessing a concealed handgun while participating in any training or other exercises where the commanding officer determines that such possession would interfere with the conduct of training.
