**4. Title:** Public elementary and secondary schools; teacher grievance procedures.

**5. Summary:** Permits a school board to conduct a teacher grievance hearing before a three-member fact-finding panel. Under current law, the school board has the option of appointing a hearing officer or conducting such hearing itself.
