- 4. Title: Definitions; nonresident
- **5. Summary:** This bill includes in the definition of "nonresident" for purposes of Title 46.2 (Motor Vehicles) a person who is in Virginia serving a 24-month or 36-month full-time church service or proselyting mission and who is not gainfully employed.
- 6. Budget Amendment Necessary: No.
- 7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Preliminary. See Item #8.
- 8. Fiscal Implications: This legislation will expand the number of persons eligible to drive in the Commonwealth without a Virginia driver's license. The exact impact upon the agency cannot be estimated at this time since the number of persons who would be eligible for the exemption is unknown; but, it is expected that the impact will be minimal and can be absorbed by the agency.

The legislation will not grant an exemption from vehicle registration unless the nonresident is from a state which grants a similar exemption to Virginia residents for the particular type of vehicle the nonresident drives. If the nonresident's home jurisdiction does not provide this exemption, then Va. Code § 46.2-656 would require the nonresident to register the vehicle after six months and they would have to pay registration fees retroactive to the date when they arrived in the Commonwealth.
