5. Summary: This bill includes in the definition of "nonresident" for purposes of Title 46.2 (Motor Vehicles) a person who is in Virginia serving a full-time church service or proselyting mission of not more than 36 months and who is not gainfully employed.

8. Fiscal Implications: This legislation will expand the number of persons eligible to drive in the Commonwealth without a Virginia driver's license. An exact impact cannot be estimated since the number of persons who would be eligible for the exemption cannot be determined; but, it is expected that the impact will be minimal and can be absorbed by the Department of Motor Vehicles.
