4. Title: Advance disclosure of allowed amount or charge for procedure.

5. Summary: Requires every hospital to furnish a patient scheduled to receive an elective procedure, test or service to be performed by the hospital, upon his request or the request of his legally authorized representative made no less than three days in advance of the date on which such elective procedure, test or service is scheduled to be performed, with an estimate of the payment amount for which the participant will be responsible for such elective procedure, test, or service.

7. No Fiscal Impact.

8. Fiscal Implications: This bill would not have a fiscal impact on the Commonwealth. This bill directs hospitals and would not impact agency operations.
