4. Title: Institutions of higher education; letter certifying good standing of certain students.

5. Summary: Requires public institutions of higher education and private institutions that are eligible to participate in Tuition Assistance Grants or the College Building Authority, to require the dean of students or similar such individual at any other institution of higher education within or outside the Commonwealth to submit to it a letter certifying the good standing of any student who seeks admission to it. The letter must certify that the applicant, at the time such student withdraws from the other institution of higher education within or outside the Commonwealth, is determined to be in good standing according to the institution's code, rules, or set of standards governing such a determination and is not under investigation or subject to any pending institutional proceedings for a violation of the institution's code, rules, or set of standards governing student conduct.
