4. Title: Auxiliary lighting on motorcycles and autocycles.

5. Summary: The proposal requires the Superintendent of State Police to establish guidelines for the submission and approval of auxiliary lights on motorcycles that are not approved by the Society of Automotive Engineers. The guidelines are to be posted on the Department of State Police's website by January 1, 2017. The legislation also requires that the approval of any lights or equipment be published on the Department's website, and the Department is to notify official safety inspection stations of such approved equipment.
