- **4. Title:** Use of restricted use pesticides.
- **5. Summary:** This bill prohibits the aerial application of restricted use pesticides for agricultural purposes within one-quarter mile of a public or private elementary or secondary school.
- 6. Budget Amendment Necessary: No.
- 7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Preliminary.
- 8. Fiscal Implications: It is anticipated that this bill will not have a fiscal impact on the Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services. The bill makes it unlawful to aerially apply restricted use pesticides for agricultural purposes within one-quarter mile of a public or private elementary or secondary school. Violators of the provisions of this section may be assessed a civil penalty determined by the Board of Agriculture and Consumer Services. Penalties are paid into the Pesticide Control Fund.
- **9.** Specific Agency or Political Subdivisions Affected: Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services.
- **10. Technical Amendment Necessary:** Yes. Line 49. The word "aerial" should be changed to "aerially".
