4. Title: Campus police departments; retention of physical evidence recovery kits.

5. Summary: Requires campus police departments to retain and store physical evidence recovery kits for a minimum of two years where the victim of the sexual assault elects not to report the sexual assault to law enforcement at the time of the collection of such evidence.

6. Budget Amendment Necessary: No.

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Indeterminate. See item 8.

8. Fiscal Implications: Some institutions of higher education, particularly smaller institutions with less financial resources or facility space, may incur nominal costs from complying with this provision. However, it is anticipated that any additional costs could be absorbed by the institutions.
