3. Committee: Senate Courts of Justice

4. Title: Purchase of service weapon

5. Summary:

Current law allows specified law enforcement and public safety personnel to purchase his or her service weapon for \$1.00 upon retirement. The proposed legislation would expand that list to include any employee of the Department of Corrections with internal investigation authority.

6. Budget Amendment Necessary: No.

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: See Item 8 below.

8. Fiscal Implications:

Because the Department of Corrections would need to replace any handgun purchased by a retired special agent, the proposal could have a fiscal impact. However, the impact would be minimal and difficult to project.

9. Specific Agency or Political Subdivisions Affected: Department of Corrections

10. Technical Amendment Necessary:

The Code section being amended by the proposed legislation has two versions: one effective until July 1, 2018 (line 13) and the other effective after July 1, 2018 (line 71). The proposed legislation does not adequately designate the two versions. At line 71, there need to be inserted a section number and header line for the version effective after July 1, 2018.
