**4. Title: Military Mission Improvement and Expansion projects**

**5. Summary:**

The proposed legislation adds Military Mission Improvement and Expansion (MMIE) Projects as a category of project eligible for financing through the Virginia Public Building Authority (VPBA). MMIE projects are defined as projects to improve, expand, develop or redevelop federal or state military installations or supporting infrastructure to enhance the military value. Funds from the VPBA could also be used for related grants to regional or local governments for the acquisition of property adjoining military installations. MMIE projects would also include the costs to acquire, construct, improve, undertake, or develop transportation, access communications, utilities, housing, environmental, security, or cyber-security infrastructure at the state, regional, or local level.

**8. Fiscal Implications:**

Any specific MMIE project would need to be recommended by the Commission on Military Installations and Defense Activities and approved by the Governor. The bill does not authorize any bonds for MMIE projects, and any amounts designated for an MMIE project would need to first be authorized by the General Assembly.
