5. Summary:

Under current law, circuit court judges may appoint special conservators of the peace, who have certain law-enforcement authority. The proposed legislation would require that person applying for appointment as a special conservator of the peace include the results of a criminal history record information check in his or her application. Another provision of the legislation would prohibit the appointment as a special conservator of the peace any person who would be prohibited by law from possessing, transporting, or purchasing a firearm.

The Department of Criminal Justice Services regulates special conservators of the peace and all persons appointed, or seeking appointment, as a special conservator of the peace are required to register with the department.
