4. Title: Nurse practitioners; practicing outside of a patient care team.

5. Summary: Authorizes a nurse practitioner to practice without the requirement for collaboration and consultation with a patient care team physician as part of a patient care team or a written or electronic practice agreement between the nurse practitioner and a physician in any clinic that is located in a medically underserved area of the state or an area of the state that has an unemployment rate of one and one-half times the statewide average unemployment rate. The bill also grants prescriptive authority to such nurse practitioners.
