**3. Committee:** Privileges and Elections

**4. Title:** Campaign finance; campaign fundraising during special and reconvened sessions prohibited.

**5. Summary:** Prohibits campaign fundraising on and after the first day of a special session of the General Assembly through adjournment sine die of that session, including any ensuing reconvened session. Currently, campaign fundraising is prohibited from the first day through adjournment sine die of regular sessions of the General Assembly, and the definition of "adjournment sine die" specifically excludes the ensuing reconvened sessions.
