**3. Committee:** Courts of Justice

**4. Title:** Concealed handgun permit; demonstration of competence.

**5. Summary:** The proposal removes the option for concealed handgun permit applicants to demonstrate competence with a handgun by completing an electronic, video, or online course conducted by a state-certified or National Rifle Association-certified firearms instructor. The bill does not affect any in person means of satisfying the requirement to demonstrate competence with a handgun under current law.

**6. Budget Amendment Necessary:** No.

**8. Fiscal Implications:** It is uncertain if the in person training requirement under the proposed legislation will impact nonresident application for concealed handgun permits issued in Virginia. The potential impact on the general fund revenue cannot be determined. The bill has no fiscal impact on the Department of State Police.
