4. Title: Alcoholic beverage control; distiller's license; tastings

5. Summary Establishes the provisions in which distilled spirits can be offered as samples to persons who can legally purchase and consume alcoholic beverages. The bill also increases from one and one-half ounces to three ounces the total quantity of spirits a distiller licensee may serve to each consumer at a tasting event.
