**4. Title:** Virginia Freedom of Information Act; mandatory disclosure of public employee position and salary.

**5. Summary:** Provides that the provisions of the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) do not require public access to the names and training records of law-enforcement officers as defined in § 9.1-101 and fire marshals as defined in § 27-30. The names and training records are considered personnel records and excluded from mandatory disclosure pursuant to § 2.2-3750.1.

Other Comments:** The bill, as engrossed, eliminated the provision that when salary information is disclosed in accordance with clause (ii) of § 2.2-3705.8, Code of Virginia, the custodian shall not be required to disclose the names of the public officers, officials, or employees that correspond to that salary information.
