**4. Title:** Part-time teacher permits.

**5. Summary:** Directs the Board of Education to provide for the issuance of temporary part-time teacher permits to qualified professionals with expertise and credentials in career and technical education areas who are recommended for the permit by employing school divisions.

**6. Budget Amendment Necessary:** No.

**7. Fiscal Impact Estimates:** Preliminary. See Item 8.

**8. Fiscal Implications:** This bill would provide flexibility to local school divisions by allowing divisions to employ temporary, part-time career and technical education (CTE) teachers, which would help to address a critical shortage teaching endorsement area in Virginia.

It is anticipated that the request to process teacher permits as defined can be absorbed within existing Department of Education resources.
