3. Committee: Senate Committee on Rehabilitation and Social Services

4. Title: Alcoholic beverage control; limited brewery licenses

5. Summary: Provides that for a limited brewery license, "land zoned agricultural" means land zoned as an agricultural district or classification, but does not include any other zoning classification or designation that permits agricultural uses. Under current law, such license may be granted only if the land is zoned agricultural.
