**4. Title:** U.S. Department of the Interior; monitoring by VMRC; Assateague Island National Seashore.

Summary:** Directs the Marine Resources Commission to monitor any effort by the U.S. Department of the Interior to expand federal jurisdiction regarding fishing or shellfish harvesting in the waters adjoining the Assateague Island National Seashore and to seek to preserve the right and ability of Virginia watermen to use such waters.
