4. Title: Issuance of certain special license plates

5. Summary: This bill prohibits the Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV) from issuing or renewing special or personalized license plates if the owner or co-owner is listed on the Sex Offender and Crimes Against Minors Registry.

6. Budget Amendment Necessary: No.

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: Preliminary. See Item #8.

8. Fiscal Implications: This engrossed bill would require \$41,391 in information technology development cost, which can be absorbed within existing resources of the Department of Motor Vehicles.

There is a possibility that this legislation could result in a minimal reduction in revenue. Special license plates and personalized license plates carry additional fees. If the engrossed bill prevents some individuals from obtaining certain plates, DMV could see a loss in revenue; however, it is not likely to be a significant amount.

Initial research on two of the authorizations that would be affected by the bill show 10 owners or co-owners on the Sex Offender and Crimes Against Minors Registry.

11. Other Comments: This bill is similar to HB 305.
