5. Summary: The proposal makes the \$10 fee that the clerk of court is now required to charge for processing a concealed handgun permit application or issuing a concealed handgun permit discretionary with the clerk.

8. Fiscal Implications: The proposal has no fiscal impact on the Commonwealth's general fund revenue collected from firearms transactions fees. The proposal affects fees collected by court clerks. Since the proposal allows for the fee assessed by the clerk of court to be discretionary charge, the impact it is not quantifiable, as it is not feasible to forecast how many clerks will choose to forego the fee.
