4. Title: Department of General Services; effect of enhancements or remedial measures on contract costs.

5. Summary: The substitute bill requires the Department of General Services to make available a dashboard of purchase order reports from the Commonwealth's statewide electronic procurement system. The dashboard shall include aggregated data showing purchase orders for the current and previous fiscal year and other relevant data derived from any enhancement or remedial measure implemented by the Governor pursuant to subsection C of § 2.2-4310, Code of Virginia.

7. Fiscal Impact Estimates: No fiscal impact; see Item 8.

8. Fiscal Implications: No fiscal impact is expected from the substitute version of the bill. The bill requires the Department of General Services (DGS) to make available a dashboard of purchase order data from eVA, the Commonwealth's statewide electronic procurement system as well as relevant data derived from enhancement or remedial measures implemented by the Governor pursuant to subsection C of § 2.2-4310, Code of Virginia. Any costs for DGS to provide the required information would be absorbed within existing resources.
