3. Committee: General Laws and Technology

4. Title: Virginia Freedom of Information Act; public access to noncriminal records.

5. Summary: Clarifies public access to noncriminal records maintained by public bodies engaged in criminal law-enforcement activities. The bill reverses an April 2015 Virginia Supreme Court decision in *Fitzgerald v. Loudoun County Sheriff's Office*, which held that a noncriminal record must be a compilation in order for the exemption for noncriminal records to apply. The bill was also the subject of a Virginia Freedom of Information Advisory Council opinion (AO-08-15) concerning this exemption, which highlighted the need for clarification of this exemption based on the *Fitzgerald* case.
