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10	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
11	1. That §§ 2.2-3704.1 and 30-179 of the Code of Virginia are amended and reenacted as follows:
12	§ 2.2-3704.1. Posting of notice of rights and responsibilities by state and local public bodies;
13	assistance by the Freedom of Information Advisory Council.
14 15	A. All state public bodies subject to the provisions of this chapter and any county or city, and any town with a population of more than 250, shall make available the following information to the public
15 16	town with a population of more than 250, shall make available the following information to the public upon request and shall post a link to such information on the homepage of their respective public
17	government websites:
18	1. A plain English explanation of the rights of a requester under this chapter, the procedures to
19	obtain public records from the public body, and the responsibilities of the public body in complying
20	with this chapter. For purposes of this section, "plain English" means written in nontechnical, readily
21	understandable language using words of common everyday usage and avoiding legal terms and phrases
22	or other terms and words of art whose usage or special meaning primarily is limited to a particular field
23	or profession;
24	2. Contact information for the FOIA officer designated by the public body pursuant to § 2.2-3704.2
25	to (i) assist a requester in making a request for records or (ii) respond to requests for public records;
26	3. A general description, summary, list, or index of the types of public records maintained by such
27	state public body;
28	4. A general description, summary, list, or index of any exemptions in law that permit or require
29 30	such public records to be withheld from release; 5. Any policy the public body has concerning the type of public records it routinely withholds from
30 31	release as permitted by this chapter or other law; and
32	6. The following statement: "A public body may make reasonable charges not to exceed its actual
33	cost incurred in accessing, duplicating, supplying, or searching for the requested records. No public body
34	shall impose any extraneous, intermediary, or surplus fees or expenses to recoup the general costs
35	associated with creating or maintaining records or transacting the general business of the public body.
36	Any duplicating fee charged by a public body shall not exceed the actual cost of duplication. All
37	charges for the supplying of requested records shall be estimated in advance at the request of the citizen
38	as set forth in subsection F of § 2.2-3704 of the Code of Virginia."
39	B. Any state public body subject to the provisions of this chapter and any county or city, and any
40	town with a population of more than 250, shall post a link on its official public government website to
41 42	the online public comment form on the Freedom of Information Advisory Council's website to enable any requester to comment on the quality of assistance provided to the requester by the public body.
43	B. C. The Freedom of Information Advisory Council, created pursuant to § 30-178, shall assist in the
<b>4</b> 4	development and implementation of the provisions of subsection A, upon request.
45	§ 30-179. Powers and duties of the Council.
46	The Council shall:
47	1. Furnish, upon request, advisory opinions or guidelines, and other appropriate information regarding
<b>48</b>	the Freedom of Information Act (§ 2.2-3700 et seq.) to any person or agency of state or local
49	government, in an expeditious manner;
50	2. Conduct training seminars and educational programs for the members and staff of public bodies
51	and other interested persons on the requirements of the Freedom of Information Act (§ 2.2-3700 et seq.);
52 53	3. Publish such educational materials as it deems appropriate on the provisions of the Freedom of
53 54	Information Act (§ 2.2-3700 et seq.);
54 55	4. Request from any agency of state or local government such assistance, services and information as will enable the Council to effectively carry out its responsibilities. Information provided to the Council
55 56	by an agency of state or local government shall not be released to any other party unless authorized by
50 57	such agency;
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59 6. Develop the public comment form for use by designated public bodies in accordance with60 subsection F of § 2.2-3708;

61 7. Develop an online public comment form to be posted on the Council's official public government
62 website to enable any requester to comment on the quality of assistance provided to the requester by a
63 public body; and

64 7. 8. Report annually on or before December 1 of each year on its activities and findings regarding
 65 the Freedom of Information Act (§ 2.2-3700 et seq.), including recommendations for changes in the law,

66 to the General Assembly and the Governor. The annual report shall be published as a state document.
