That § 1, as amended, and § 3 of Chapter XXV (A.1) of Chapter 431 of the Acts of Assembly of 12 1950 are amended and reenacted as follows: 13 § 1. Created; general function; composition; appointment and terms of members. 14 There shall be a regional wastewater treatment facility commission which shall be known as the 15 16 Hopewell Water Renewal Commission (hereinafter in this chapter referred to as the "Commission"), which shall act on behalf of the City of Hopewell as hereinafter provided, with respect to a regional 17 wastewater treatment facility to be owned by the City of Hopewell to provide treatment for disposal of 18 sanitary and industrial waste from the City of Hopewell and vicinity. The Commission shall consist of 19 20 eight members who need not be residents of the city and who shall be appointed by a majority of city 21 council. Five of such members Members shall be from nominees submitted by five manufacturers (each 22 nominating with respect to one membership) which provide assistance in the planning and financing of 23 for the regional wastewater treatment facility or which are or will be users of said facility. Each manufacturer shall provide a capital contribution in an amount determined by the city council. 24 25 Additional members shall be a city councilor, the city manager, and the city attorney. Any vacancy in 26 the appointive membership of the Commission, however occurring, shall be promptly filled by the city 27 council for the unexpired term in the same manner and from the same source as the original 28 appointment to the vacated position. 29 Council may provide for additional nominees to the Commission by manufacturers not involved in 30 planning assistance as aforesaid who contract with the city to provide a capital contribution of four per 31 centum or more of the original capital cost of the facility by increasing the Commission membership to 32

provide for one nominee from each such manufacturer.

§ 3. Powers and duties.

34 The Commission shall help and assist in the planning and construction maintenance and expansion of 35 the facility. The Commission shall exercise full authority and responsibility in the operation, 36 maintenance, improvement and repair of the facility, subject, however, to overrule of any of its actions 37 by the city council. The Commission shall have such further duties as the city council may from time to 38 time direct.

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
