| 11     | 1. That § 63.2-505.2 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:                           |
| 12     | § 63.2-505.2. Eligibility for food stamps; drug-related felonies.   |
| 13     | A person who is otherwise eligible to receive food stamp benefits shall be exempt from the                  |
| 14     | application of section 115(a) of the Personal Responsibility and Work Opportunity Reconciliation Act of     |
| 15     | 1996, P.L. 104-193, and shall not be denied such assistance solely because he has been convicted of a       |
| 16     | felony offense of possession of a controlled substance in violation of § 18.2-250 or a first-time felony    |
| 17     | offense of possession with intent to distribute a controlled substance in violation of § 18.2-248, provided |
| 18     | that such person (i) is complying with, or has already complied with, all obligations imposed by the        |
| 19     | criminal court; (ii) is actively engaged in or has completed a substance abuse treatment program; (iii)     |
| 20     | participates in periodic drug screenings-; and (iv) is complying with or has already complied with any      |

20 participates in periodic drug screenings; and (iv) *i* other obligations as determined by the Department.
