It is unlawful for any person to use or operate an unmanned aircraft system as defined in § 19.2-60.1 to trespass upon the property of another for the purpose of secretly or furtively peeping, spying, or attempting to peep or spy into a dwelling or occupied building located on such property. A violation of this section is a Class I misdemeanor. The provisions of this section shall not apply to a lawful criminal investigation.
