6 **Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:**7 **1. That § 18.2-308.011 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:**8 **§ 18.2-308.011. Replacement permits.**

9 A. The clerk of a circuit court that issued a valid concealed handgun permit shall, upon presentation
10 *by the permit holder* of the valid permit and ~~proof of a new address of residence by the permit holder~~
11 *written notice of a change of address on a form provided by the Department of State Police*, issue a
12 replacement permit specifying the permit holder's new address. The clerk of court shall forward the
13 permit holder's new address of residence to the State Police. The State Police may charge a fee not to
14 exceed \$5, and the clerk of court issuing the replacement permit may charge a fee not to exceed \$5. The
15 total amount assessed for processing a replacement permit pursuant to this subsection shall not exceed
16 \$10, with such fees to be paid in one sum to the person who receives the information for the
17 replacement permit.

18 B. The clerk of a circuit court that issued a valid concealed handgun permit shall, upon submission
19 of a notarized statement by the permit holder that the permit was lost or destroyed or that the permit
20 holder has undergone a legal name change, issue a replacement permit. The replacement permit shall
21 have the same expiration date as the permit that was lost, destroyed, or issued to the permit holder
22 under a previous name. The clerk shall issue the replacement permit within 10 business days of
23 receiving the notarized statement and may charge a fee not to exceed \$5.
