9	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
10	1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding a section numbered 24.2-1004.1 as follows:
11	§ 24.2-1004.1. Payments for registering to vote; penalties.
12	A. Any person who gives, offers, or promises any payment to another in exchange for that person
13	registering to vote is guilty of a Class 5 felony.
14	B. Any person who solicits or accepts any payment from another in exchange for his registering to
15	vote is guilty of a Class 1 misdemeanor.
16	2. That the provisions of this act may result in a net increase in periods of imprisonment or
17	commitment. Pursuant to § 30-19.1:4, the estimated amount of the necessary appropriation cannot
18	be determined for periods of imprisonment in state adult correctional facilities; therefore, Chapter
19	780 of the Acts of Assembly of 2016 requires the Virginia Criminal Sentencing Commission to
20	assign a minimum fiscal impact of \$50,000. Pursuant to § 30-19.1:4, the estimated amount of the
