9	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
10	1. That § 22.1-23 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
11	§ 22.1-23. Duties in general.
12 13 14	The Superintendent of Public Instruction shall:
13	1. Serve as secretary of the Board of Education;
14	2. Provide such assistance in his office as shall be necessary for the proper and uniform enforcement
15	of the provisions of the school laws in cooperation with the local school authorities;
16	3. Prepare and furnish such forms for attendance officers, teachers and other school officials as are
17	required by law;
18	4. (Expires July 1, 2020) At least annually, survey all local school divisions to identify critical
19 20	shortages of teachers and administrative personnel by geographic area, by school division, or by subject
20 21	matter, and report such critical shortages to each local school division and to the Virginia Retirement System;
21 22	5. <del>Develop</del> In order to track and make public the rate of and reasons for teacher turnover, develop
23	and provide to local school divisions a model an exit questionnaire for teachers; require each school
24	board to administer such questionnaire to each exiting teacher and to provide the results of each such
25	questionnaire to the Department of Education; and report annually to the Governor, the House
26	Committee on Education, and the Senate Committee on Education and Health the rate of and reasons
27	for teacher turnover based on the results of such questionnaires;
28	6. Along with the State Health Commissioner, work to combat childhood obesity and other chronic
29	health conditions that affect school-age children;
30	7. Designate an employee of the Department of Education to serve as its liaison to the State Council

of Higher Education for Virginia and the State Board for Community Colleges; and
8. Perform such other duties as the Board of Education may prescribe.
