10	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
11	1. That § 18.2-309 of the Code of Virginia is amended and reenacted as follows:
12	§ 18.2-309. Furnishing certain weapons to minors; penalty.
13	A. If any person sells, barters, gives or furnishes, or causes to be sold, bartered, given or furnished,
14	to any minor a dirk, switchblade knife or bowie knife, having good cause to believe him to be a minor,
15	such person shall be guilty of a Class 1 misdemeanor. This subsection shall not apply to any transfer
16	made between family members or for the purpose of engaging in a sporting event or activity.
17	B. If any person sells, barters, gives or furnishes, or causes to be sold, bartered, given or furnished,
18	to any minor a handgun, having good cause to believe him to be a minor, such person shall be guilty of

a Class 6 felony. This subsection shall not apply to any transfer made between family members or forthe purpose of engaging in a sporting event or activity.
